



80 per cent of Victoria's COVID related deaths aged care residents

It has been revealed 80 per cent of Victoria's 820 coronavirus related deaths were aged care residents.

The virus infiltrated 110 aged care facilities with St Basil's Homes for the Aged breaking the grim record of 44 COVID-19 related deaths.

A former employee of St Basil's told Sky News there was not enough staff to feed the residents and they were not informed of the first COVID case or instructed to wear PPE.

The St Basil's chairman stepped down following the tragedy and a coronial inquiry into the deaths is underway as well as an independent review and WorkSafe investigation.
